

SupplyCore Inc. expands capabilities for FASI Global initiative

SupplyCore Inc. recently completed the implementation of its portion of the Fleet Automotive Support Initiative Global (FASI-G) contract and assumed full control of operations Sept. 15.

In addition to the unrestricted FASI-G contract awarded to Lockheed Martin, Defense Supply Center Columbus awarded a small business set-aside contract to SupplyCore Inc. in December 2008.

Under this contract, SupplyCore provides spare and replacements parts for the U.S. military's land-based, tactical and non-tactical vehicle fleets. During the first three stages of implementation,

SupplyCore acquired an additional warehouse, upgraded existing warehouses, staffed a new office in Columbus, and began full warehouse operations at all locations.

SupplyCore's new warehouse is located in Kansas City, Mo. SupplyCore's existing Santa Fe Springs, Calif., warehouse has moved into a new, larger facility with more capacity to hold FASI-G parts. The Santa Fe Springs facility now has more than 11,000 square feet of storage.

All of SupplyCore's current warehouses have 24/7 customer service via an emergency phone number as well as emergency order shipping available on holidays and weekends.

Our existing warehousing and transportation centers in Atlanta and Santa Fe Springs complement the reach of our newest FASI-G dedicated location in Kansas City. These facilities supported by our exceptional manufacturers, OEMS and our in-house supply chain management professionals in our Rockford, Ill., facility, have enabled us to exceed our requirements and meet the demands of our customers," stated David Hahn, SupplyCore's vice president of corporate development.

DSCC had already begun ordering parts through SupplyCore's FASI-G contract and is

able to view order status and customized reports via SupplyCore's online procurement system.

SupplyCore has steadily become one of the leading integrated suppliers, offering integrated logistics, supply chain management, and Web-based procurement services for the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force

and Marine Corps as well as other federal government organizations. Founded in 1987, SupplyCore currently has more than 130 associates with offices and distribution centers located in Illinois, California, South Carolina, Atlanta, Missouri, Japan, Saudi Arabia and Kuwait.
