The Global Fleet Automotive Support Initiative (FASI-G) is a program developed by the Defense Logistics Agency to provide **CONUS and OCONUS logistical support** throughout the entire supply chain for **land-based tactical and non-tactical vehicle fleets** worldwide. The United States Army and Marine Corps are currently benefitting from the FASI-G program. However, any DoD activity with land-based vehicles is included in the program, including the Reserves and National Guard.

The reliable delivery performance of FASI allows you to adjust your inventory levels to reflect the enhanced logistics response time (LRT). SupplyCore will provide direct delivery to your activity's retail and maintenance level areas, thus mitigating the need to maintain large local inventories.

SupplyCore will establish strategic transportation and source networks within each CONUS region being supported, further reducing LRT. SupplyCore is obligated to perform delivery based on the priority of customer requisitions.

SupplyCore will provide a customer service representative (CSR) that is dedicated to the region. The CSR will provide requisition status, help identify weaknesses in maintenance and internal logistics activities and provide technical expertise and training when necessary.
